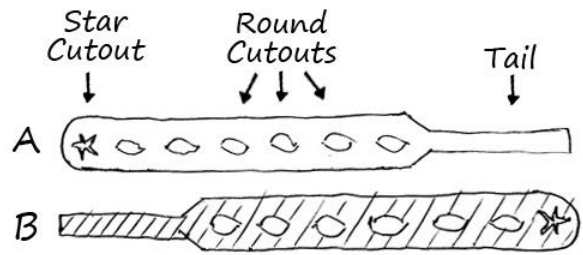


A Bracelet Craft for Kids!

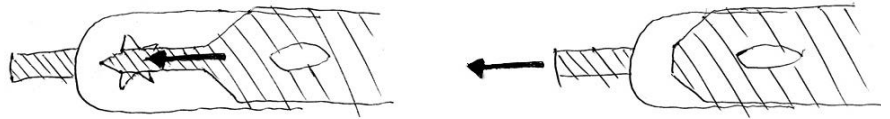
Your kids can make their own leather bracelets with this easy craft.
Children under age 10 may need help from a parent.

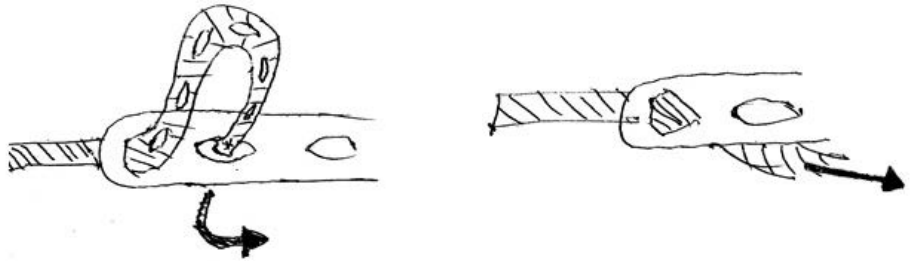
STEP 1: Start with two pieces of leather. Each piece has star cutout on one end, a tail on the other end and several round cutouts throughout the middle. In these illustrations, the lighter piece is labeled A and the darker piece is labeled B.



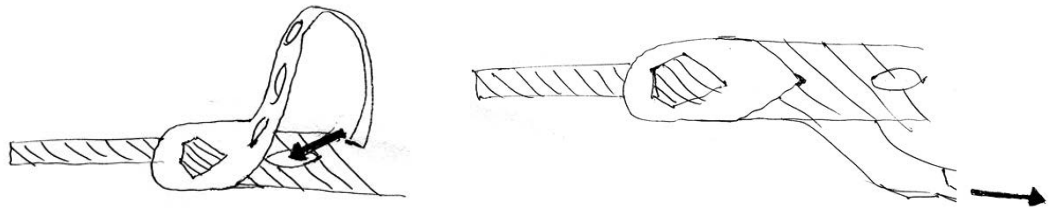
STEP 2: Take the tail of piece B and insert it through the star cutout of piece A (hint: the side of the leather you would like to be visible on the outside of the final bracelet should be facing you). Pull the tail of piece B until the whole tail slides through.



STEP 3: Take the opposite end of piece B (the end with the star cutout) and push it through the first round cutout on piece A. Pull this end of piece A all the way through the cutout.



STEP 4: Insert the tail of piece A through the first round cutout of piece B and pull it all the way through.



STEP 5: Repeat steps 3–4 until all the round cutouts are filled.

STEP 6: Push the tail of piece A through the star cutout of piece A and pull it all the way through.



All done! You can now tie the bracelet around your wrist.
